Dear Sir

In reply to your letter of 23 January 2007, I have again spoken to Peter Reed, Senior Compliance Officer, responsible for dog bins in Worthing. He informs me that unfortunately the budget for waste collection from dog bins is already overspent. Each bin costs approximately £170 per year to empty and I believe around the same to purchase and install (one off).

The Council is therefore, at present, unable to expand the collection, even with your kind offer to pay for the actual bins. Whether this position may change in future depends on the amount of money allotted for dog bins and waste collection. Further enquiries about dog bins/waste collection should be sent directly to Mr Peter Reed, Senior Compliance Officer, Worthing and Adur Services, Commerce Way, Lancing.
