## **FVRA Statement for the Annual General Meeting 23 April 2010**

Our residents' association celebrates its 73<sup>rd</sup> anniversary this year, having achieved some significant milestones in our core objective of protecting and promoting the interests of all households living in Findon Valley.

- The installation of a second pedestrian crossing at the surgery/library point across the A24 and a new pedestrian crossing on Warren Road/A27.
- Improved paving and road barriers on both sides of the A24 pedestrian crossing at King's Parade/Cissbury Court.
- We have forged even closer links with Worthing Council and other authorities as well as building strategic working relationships with groups like the S. Downs Network, the Cissbury Sell Off Campaign, Vale School and the High Salvington Residents' Association.
- A recent revamp of our website communicating to The Big Wide World.
- We had some hugely successful events. A 'Late Night Christmas Shopping Experience' at King's Parade raised over £1000 in 2009 for Chestnut Tree House Children's Hospice and Make a Wish Foundation. This year we helped run an 'Easter Treasure Hunt' with local shops, which brought about 37 entries from children, of which 22 won prizes, and increased business for most outlets!
- We also reverted back to our original FVRA name, which was founded in 1936.

We also made an important change to our Constitution. The following article was removed:

### ***"Item 6. Officers."***

***"All of whom shall relinquish their office every year & shall be eligible for re-election at the Annual General Meeting. A member who has been elected Chairman for four successive years shall not be eligible to hold the office for a fifth consecutive year. A President and Vice President may also be elected at a General Meeting of the Society, for periods to be decided at such a meeting".***

Out of the 1863 households we represent in Findon Valley we currently have around 1100 as fully paid-up FVRA members. A special thanks to everyone who has loyally supported us, members and the hard-working FVRA voluntary team alike, making sure that everything happens for all our benefits!
